EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM IN YOUR COUNTRY

Pre-school:

Main objectives: *to prepare children for the primary*

Primary:

Main objectives: *to teach to children how to read, to write and count. To make them learn the fundamental notions.*

Secondary:

Main objectives: *To more thoroughly into the notions learned in primary. Moreover, to learn new notions and languages which will be useful later.*

WHAT ARE, IN YOUR OPINION, THE MOST POSITIVE ASPECTS OF THIS SYSTEM OF EDUCATION?

WHAT ARE, IN YOUR OPINION, THE NEGATIVE ASPECTS OF THIS SYSTEM OF EDUCATION?

To my opinion the negative aspects of this system are that we start to learn new languages too late and that this system could be too difficult for students in difficulties.

WHAT ARE LESSONS USUALLY LIKE IN YOUR SCHOOL?

Usually, we have like 7 hours of lesson per day and each lesson lasts 1 hour. To my mind this is too long. During lessons the teacher speaks and we write and take notes of what he is saying. Sometimes we do exercises or we write lessons...

HOW WOULD YOU LIKE THEM TO BE?

I'd like them to be more focused on the oral participation. And I'd like them to last 45 minutes because one hour is too long and at the end we aren't focused anymore.

IN YOUR COUNTRY, CLASSES ARE MORE THEORETICAL OR PRACTICAL?

It depends on the subject. For example, physics and biology are really practical because we do a lot of experiments which are interesting. But on the other hand subjects like mathematics or history are very theoretical which is so boring..

My favourite subjects are physics and English. Physics because we do a lot of experiments which all interest me and English because we do a lot of oral participation.

To my mind a teacher should be patient and attentive to the students because sometimes they shout for nothing. Attentive because some students are in difficulties and it's really important to realize that because maybe they need help.

WHAT ARE THE MAIN DIFFERENCES BETWEEN YOUR SYSTEM OF EDUCATION AND THE POLAND ONE.

The main differences of these two school systems are the last of the lesson and the number of students in the class. Indeed, one lesson in Poland lasts 45minutes and they finish school earlier (beginning of afternoon). Secondly, there are less students in class because in France we are like 37 students in my class.
